



Step 1

• Be sure to have Congo Pro Front Hoop (55015) and JK-MOD-RAK Low-Pro (55070) installed on JEEP prior to installation of Spreader Bars (55045).



Step 2

• Remove end caps from the ends of the extrusion on the JK-MOD-RAK Low-Pro.




Step 3


- Slide one 5/16" x 3/4" carriage bolt into the top of the extrusion from the front.
- Slide one 5/16" x 3/4" carriage bolt into the top of the extrusion through the middle cutout and slide to the rear.
- Slide one 5/16" x 3/4" carriage bolt into the side of the extrusion in the rear.



Step 4

• Place end of spreader bar on top of extrusion while aligning carriage bolts previously installed. Bolt spreader bar to extrusion using carriage two carriage bolts, two 5/16" flat washers and two 5/16" NYLOC nuts.





Step 5

• Bolt the middle of the spreader bar to the extrusion using one carriage bolt, 5/16" flat washer and 5/16" NYLOC nut.



Step 6

- Place front clamp of Spreader Bars around the A-frame and bolt using twelve 5/16" 18 x 7/8" socket head cap screws.
- Keep clamps loose to allow adjustment.





**The bend in the spreader bars should bend in towards eachother.



Step 7

• Repeat on driver side.

Step 8

- Go back through and tighten all bolts from previous steps.
- Your installation is complete.
